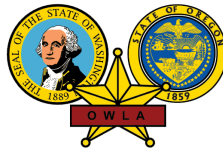


# **OWLA Fall Conference Training Announcement**



**October 7 & 8, 2010**

**The Oregon-Washington Lawmen's Association Fall 2010 Training Conference will be held at the Best Western Icicle Inn, Leavenworth, Washington.**

## **DARK VOYAGE – THE MURDERS OF TOM & JACKIE HAWKS**

***Instructor – Sergeant Dave Byington  
California Newport Beach Police Department***

*Sergeant David Byington and his partner, Sergeant Evan Sailor, were the lead investigators in the Newport Beach Police Hawks Homicide investigation. Sergeant Byington will discuss how in November of 2004, Tom and Jackie Hawks of Newport Beach placed an advertisement for their 55-foot boat named "Well Deserved" for \$440,000. They wanted to spend more time with their new grandchild in Arizona. Skylar Deleon and his wife Jennifer masterminded a conspiracy that involved everybody from gang members from the Long Beach Insane Crips to a former Orange County jailer to brutally murder the Hawks by taking them out at sea, overpowering the couple with tasers and forcing them to sign over transfer of title documents for the yacht. Once the paperwork was completed, the suspects tied the Hawks, who were handcuffed and blindfolded, to the boat's anchor and ultimately threw them overboard alive. This case has been featured on 20/20, Dateline, 48 Hours, and has been the subject of one completed and one pending novel.*

## **COVERT INVESTIGATIVE & INTELLIGENCE SUPPORT – CAPTURING FUGITIVES IN THE US & ABROAD**

***Instructor – Supervisory Inspector Angel "Tito" Del Valle, U. S. Marshals Service***

*The U. S. Marshals Service, Technical Operations Group (TOG) Electronic Surveillance Branch (ESB) using sophisticated electronic technologies provides covert investigative and intelligence support for both federal and state fugitive investigations. In addition to investigative operations, ESB helps agencies draft court orders, and trains law enforcement personnel from the United States and the international law enforcement community in the use of electronic surveillance. Supervisory Inspector Tito Del Valle will provide an updated presentation as to these resources, to include the always revolving world of cell phone protocols. He will also present several case reviews showing how these technologies assisted law enforcement agencies in successfully capturing fugitives in the United States and overseas.*

## **OPERATIONAL RESPONSE & INVESTIGATIVE ONLINE NETWORK (ORION)**

***Instructors – FBI Special Agents Cynthia Hlebak & Marty Prewett***

*The Operational Response and Investigative Online Network (ORION) is sponsored by the FBI's Critical Incident Response Group (CIRG). ORION is the FBI's next generation Crisis Information Management System (CIMS). ORION provides case management and related information*

*processing capabilities to support Federal, State, Local, and Tribal law enforcement and/or emergency personnel in a coordinated response to a crisis at a special event or a critical incident such as political party conventions, kidnappings and terrorist attacks.*

*ORION is a secure, web-based crisis management application hosted on the Law Enforcement Online (LEO) website. ORION standardizes case management processes, enhances situational awareness, and supports the exchange of information.*

*ORION is a robust, flexible, scalable system that supports the investigative needs of the Law Enforcement Officer/Detective, as well as appropriate investigative personnel from other agencies. It has the capability to capture, search, and analyze data provided in thousands of emails and telephone tips and supports the conversion of raw information into actionable leads in a timely manner.*

## **CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN CHILD ABDUCTION RAPID DEPLOYMENT (CARD) TEAM**

*It is the mission of the FBI's Crimes Against Children Unit to provide a quick and effective response to all incidents of crimes against children. The first few hours after a child is abducted are critical, and that is why we have established the Child Abduction Rapid Deployment (CARD) Teams.*

*The CARD Teams are designed to deploy teams of 4–6 experienced personnel to provide on-the-ground investigative, technical, and resource assistance to state and local law enforcement. The CARD Teams consist of Crimes Against Children investigators who have in-depth experience in child abduction cases. The nationwide CARD Team consists of 48 members organized into 10 teams serving five regions across the country. They work closely with FBI Behavioral Analysis Unit representatives, National Center for the Analysis of Violent Crime Coordinators, and Crimes Against Children Coordinators.*

*In addition to their unique expertise, CARD Teams are capable of quickly establishing an on-site command post to centralize investigative efforts and operations. Other assets they bring to the table include a new mapping tool to identify and locate registered sex offenders in the area, national and international lead coverage, and the Child Abduction Response Plan to guide investigative efforts.*

*CARD Teams are primarily involved in non-family child abductions, ransom child abductions, and mysterious disappearances of children. They work with state and local law enforcement to protect and save the lives of innocent children.*
