## **“The Grim Sleeper” – Murder Case Study**

***In the mid-1980’s several dead women were discovered in the alleyways and dumpsters in South Los Angeles, California. Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department and Los Angeles Police Department began investigating the murders, creating the Southside Slayer Task Force. These crimes were announced to the public on September 23, 1985. Eventually, the LAPD and Sheriff’s detectives realized several serial killers were murdering women, and it became a difficult task for the detectives to decide which murders were linked.***

***Two decades later, the perpetrator of these crimes was dubbed “Grim Sleeper”, due to a long period of apparent inactivity between crimes. The investigation identified 230 potential cold case files that may or may not be attributed to the Grim Sleeper suspect, Lonnie Franklin, Jr. The cases span four decades from the 1970’s to the present day. Franklin, a 57-year-old one-time city employee, was arrested on July 7, 2010.***

***Since June 2007, Detective Coulter has been a member of the task force assigned to investigate a series of murders beginning in 1985 and ending with the July 2010 arrest of suspect Lonnie David Franklin, Jr., referred to by the media as the “Grim Sleeper”.***

## **Zina Linnik Child Abduction – Murder Case Study**

***On July 4th, 2007, 12-year-old Zina Linnik was abducted by a sex offender from the alley behind her home. The subsequent investigation was one of the largest in Tacoma Police Department history. Several agencies were involved in the search, including the FBI and National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. Within four days of the abduction, Terapon Adhahn was apprehended. Four days later, Adhahn led detectives to Zina's body. Adhahn was linked via DNA to the victim as well as an unsolved rape/abduction that occurred years earlier. Adhahn eventually pled guilty as charged to aggravated first degree murder, rape and kidnapping. This case study is meant to provide the audience with an understanding of the challenges police faced during this investigation, and to share lessons learned and resources available to law enforcement in the event of a child abduction.***

## **The Murder of Heather Snively & Unborn Son**

***Heather Snively was due to give birth to her first child, Baby John, in July of 2009. On June 5, 2009, Snively answered Korena Roberts' Craigslist ad seeking baby clothes and traveled to her residence. Korena Roberts brutally beat Snively to death and cut her unborn baby from her womb. A 9-1-1 call was placed from Roberts' residence. Rescue workers arrived to find Roberts' boyfriend performing CPR on the baby, who wasn't breathing. Roberts and the baby were taken to the hospital, where investigators learned that she hadn't given birth to the boy. Doctors were unable to revive him. Snively was later found stuffed in a crawl space under Roberts' house. This case received international attention and prompted major changes in Oregon law.***
