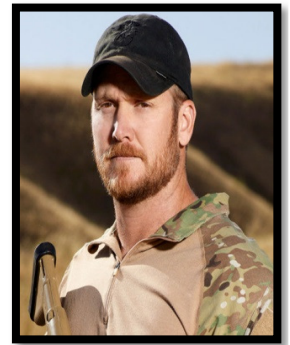

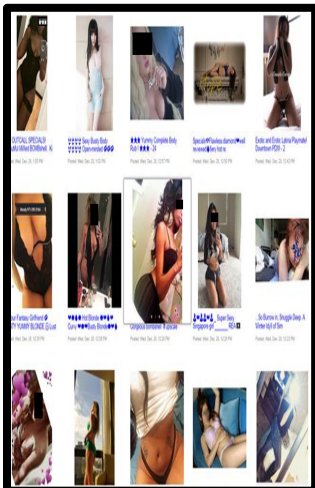

Sex Trafficking in the 21st Century

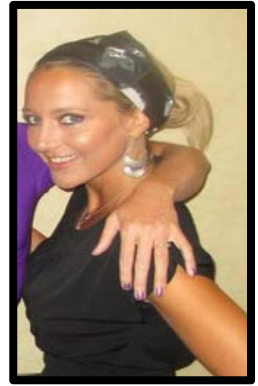
From the urban street corner to the homes and cellphones of rural communities, the internet, apps and social media have transformed the way traffickers recruit, groom and sell victims. Indicators, investigation techniques, and creative prosecutions will be discussed using recent state and federal case studies. In the Northwest, victim centered investigations, patience and hard work have resulted in unprecedented convictions and sentences for traffickers, using creative means to prove this lucrative and growing crime.

Senior Deputy District Attorney and Special Assistant U.S. Attorney J. R. Ujifusa presents all aspects of sex trafficking investigations and prosecution, using his last eight years of experience being the full-time primary prosecutor for sex trafficking cases in Multnomah County.



Tiffany Jenks Homicide Case

On October 8, 2013, Tiffany Jenks, a beautiful, young, vibrant woman was found shot to death at the entrance of Blue Lake Park in Fairview, Oregon. Investigators were faced with a bizarre “stranger danger” murder. The investigation took police to Pendleton, Oregon; all over Portland; Kelso and Longview, Washington; and finally to Oakland, California. This case displays the importance of relentless interviewing, polygraphs, partnerships, and sheer luck.



Presenting this case will be investigators from the Oregon State Police and Fairview Police Department.

Captain Phillips Story – The Maersk Alabama Cargo Ship Hijacking



April 8 – 12, 2009



The Maersk - Alabama hijacking and kidnapping of Captain Phillips began when four Somalia pirates seized the aforementioned cargo ship and later attempted to kidnap its captain. The incident ended with the surrender of one pirate and the rescue of Captain Phillips from the three remaining pirates. Supervisory Special Agent (SSA) Vincent Dalfonzo's presentation will focus on: 1) the complexities of a maritime hostage taking event and the United States Government's response; 2) will discuss the FBI's role in the situational/behavioral assessment of the incident; and 3) outline the FBI's negotiations strategies used in this matter.
