**Star Football Player Aaron Hernandez Murder Investigation  
& Gangs in the NFL**

*Presented by Detective Lieutenant Michael King and Trooper Jeremiah Donovan, Massachusetts State Police*

The presentation will consist of a complete debrief of the high profile investigation into the June 17, 2013, murder of Boston Bandits football player Odin Lloyd. Discussed will be the difficulties of investigating a celebrity/sports figure, covert investigation vs. media circus, and the coordination with non-law enforcement companies during an investigation. The presentation will also cover the subsequent trials and convictions of New England Patriots star football player Aaron Hernandez, and confederates Ernest Wallace and Carlos Ortiz.

On April 15, 2015, Hernandez was found guilty of first-degree murder, as well as five weapon charges, which required a mandatory sentence of life in prison without the possibility of parole. In 2017, Hernandez was found dead in his prison cell after apparently hanging himself with a bedsheet.

**Case Presentation**  
**San Bernardino Terrorist Attack – Mass Shooting & Attempted Bombing**

*Presented by Assistant Sheriff Steve Higgins, San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department*

On December 2, 2015, 14 people were killed and 22 others were wounded in a terrorist attack when two shooters opened fire during a work Christmas party. The victims and suspects worked together at the Department of Public Health. The suspects, Syed Rizwan Farook and Tashfeen Malik, were later killed in a shootout with law enforcement officers.



Snapshot is a cutting-edge forensic DNA analysis service that provides a variety of tools for solving hard cases quickly. Snapshot is ideal for generating investigative leads, narrowing suspect lists, and solving human remains cases, without wasting time and money chasing false leads. During this presentation, instructors will go over the following three topics and how they can be used to provide leads to your investigations.

- **Genetic Genealogy (GG):** Identify a subject by matching their DNA to one or more family members. GG is the combination of genetic analysis with traditional historical and genealogical research to study family history. For forensic investigations, it can be used to identify remains by tying the DNA to a family with a missing person or to point to the likely identity of a perpetrator.
- **DNA Phenotyping:** Predict physical appearance and ancestry of an unknown person from their DNA.
- **Kinship Inference:** Determine kinship between DNA samples out to six degrees of relatedness.
